

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy governs the manner in which Dubois Telephone Exchange, Inc. (Company) collects, uses, maintains and discloses information collected from users (each, a "User") of the <http://www.duboistelephone.com> website ("Site"). This privacy policy applies to the Site and all products and services offered by the Company.

Personal identification information

We may collect personal identification information from Users in a variety of ways, including, but not limited to, when Users visit our site, respond to a survey, fill out a form, and in connection with other activities, services, features or resources we make available on our Site. Users may be asked for, as appropriate, name, email address, mailing address, phone number. Users may, however, visit our Site anonymously. We will collect personal identification information from Users only if they voluntarily submit such information to us. Users can always refuse to supply personally identification information, except that it may prevent them from engaging in certain Site related activities.

Non-personal identification information

We may collect non-personal identification information about Users whenever they interact with our Site. Non-personal identification information may include the browser name, the type of computer and technical information about Users means of connection to our Site, such as the operating system and the Internet service providers utilized and other similar information. The Company may from time to time automatically measure and monitor network performance and the performance of Internet connections in order to improve the level of service. The Company does not share information collected for the purpose of network or computer performance monitoring or for providing customized technical support outside of the Company or its authorized vendors, contractors and agents.

Web browser cookies

Our Site may use "cookies" to enhance User experience. User's web browser places cookies on their hard drive for record-keeping purposes and sometimes to track information about them. User may choose to set their web browser to refuse cookies, or to alert you when cookies are being sent. If they do so, note that some parts of the Site may not function properly.

How we use collected information

The Company collects and uses Users personal information for the following purposes:

- To improve customer service
 - Your information helps us to more effectively respond to your customer service requests and support needs.
- To improve level of service
 - Your information helps us measure and monitor network performance and the performance of Internet connections.
- To administer a content, promotion, survey or other Site feature
 - To send Users information they agreed to receive about topics we think will be of interest to them.
- To send periodic e-mails
- The email address Users provide for order processing, will only be used to send them information and updates pertaining to their order. It may also be used to respond to their inquiries, and/or other requests or questions. If User decides to opt-in to our mailing list, they will receive emails that may include company news, updates, related product or service information, etc. If at any time the User would like to unsubscribe from receiving future emails, we include detailed unsubscribe instructions at the bottom of each email or User may contact us via our Site.

How we protect your information

We adopt appropriate data collection, storage and processing practices and security measures to protect against unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure or destruction of your personal information, username, password, transaction information and data stored on our Site.

Sharing your personal information

We do not sell, trade, or rent Users personal identification information to others. We may share generic aggregated demographic information not linked to any personal identification information regarding visitors and users with our business partners, trusted affiliates and advertisers for the purposes outlined above.

Third party websites

Users may find advertising or other content on our Site that link to the sites and services of our partners, suppliers, advertisers, sponsors, licensors and other third parties. We do not control the content or links that appear on these sites and are not responsible for the practices employed by websites linked to or from our Site. In addition, these sites or services, including their content and links, may be constantly changing. These sites and services may have their own privacy policies and customer service policies. Browsing and interaction on any other website, including websites which have a link to our Site, is subject to that website's own terms and policies.

CPNI

Customer Proprietary Network Information means: A) information that relates to the quantity, technical configuration, type, destination, and amount of use of a telecommunications service subscribed to by any customer of a telecommunications carrier, and that is made available to the carrier solely by virtue of the carrier-customer relationship; and B) information contained in the bill pertaining to telephone exchange service or telephone toll service received by a customer of a carrier; except that such term does not include subscriber list information (the listed names of subscribers, subscribers' telephone numbers, addresses, or primary advertising classifications, or any combination of such listed names, numbers, addresses, or classifications; and that the Company has published, caused to be published, or accepted for publication in any directory format).

The Company considers the personal information contained in our business records to be confidential. The Company has chosen not to use this CPNI data to specifically target customers that may benefit directly from Company or affiliate products or services. The Company also does not seek to use this information to tailor service offerings to fulfill unique customer needs.

The Company has employed procedures and safeguards in order to achieve reasonable measures designed to discover and protect against pretexting. Pretexting means the practice of pretending to be a particular customer or other authorized person in order to obtain access to that customer's call detail or other private communications records. For customer-initiated telephone inquiries, correct password that matches what is on file will be required before information may be provided. If the customer does not provide the correct password, the Company will only release the requested data via a mailing to the address of record for the account, or by a call to the number of record. For in-person visits to business office, the Company requires that the customer present valid photo identification. For online access to customer records, a password is required.

Changes to this privacy policy

The Company has the discretion to update this privacy policy at any time. When we do, we will revise the updated date at the bottom of this page. We encourage Users to frequently check this page for any changes to stay informed about how we are helping to protect the personal information we collect. You acknowledge and agree that it is your responsibility to review this privacy policy periodically and become aware of modifications.
